- 6. How much does a background check cost?
  - \$25/person at Academia West
  - \$40/person at Tooele School District
- 7. What forms of payment are accepted? Cash, check, or card
- 8. What documentation do I need to bring? A picture ID and the school form so that it is coded correctly to our system. This form is available in the front office, or you may contact Mrs. Gailey and she will send you a PDF document. You will also be required to fill out a consent form that allows Scholar to view your background check anytime.
- 9. Can I bring in a background check that I have already done? The only background checks that are accepted are the ones done via LiveScan.
- 10. Can I bring in a background check from the PD? Fingerprints done at the city offices or police department are not valid
